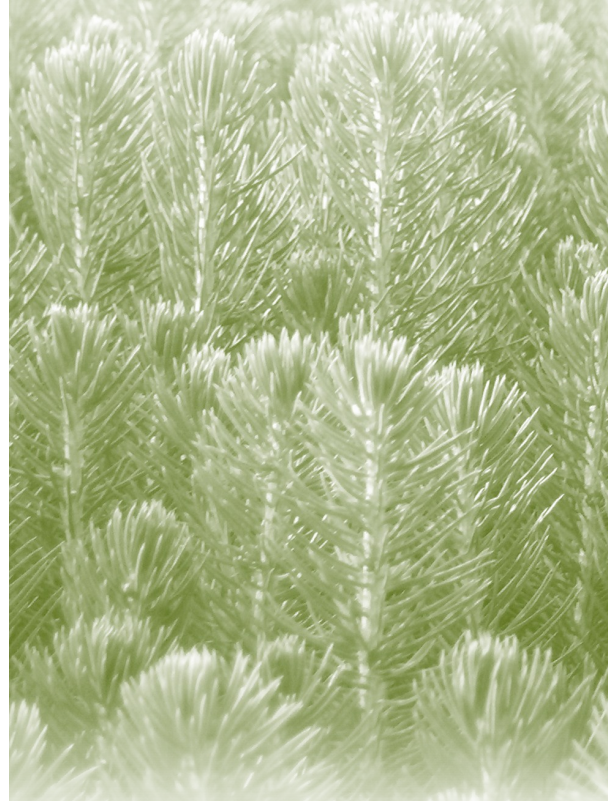

Field stops involve walking through forest stands on uneven ground, so participants should dress appropriately.

The 2011 Inland Empire Society of American Foresters meeting will be held in Sandpoint, ID, September 22-24. Registration opens Thursday (9/22). Beginning on Friday (9/23) we'll visit the Priest River Experimental Forest, which is celebrating its 100-year anniversary. Established in 1911, it was one of the first experimental forests designated as a forestry research center. The 6,368 acre forest is representative of the major forested ecosystems of the Rocky Mountains and has been, and continues to be, a priceless research tool.

Following the tour we will have dinner and an awards banquet at the historic Sandpoint Events Center. In addition we will have the privilege of being joined by several foresters from France who are touring the U.S.

On Saturday (9/24) after the annual business meeting, there will be a series of presentations to discuss how PREF research has been applied in our managed forests.
