Civil Papers:

Arrests:

- On 03/15/2005 at about 09:57, a 69 year old Juliaetta woman was summonsed for writing bad checks.
- On 3/16/2005 at about 13:01, a twenty year old Moscow man was arrested for third degree arson. The man admitted to having set three small grass fires near the Eastman Acres subdivision. The fires were put out by Moscow Fire Dept. before they spread to any structures.
- On 03/18/2005 at about 00:57, a twenty-five year old Potlatch woman was arrested in Potlatch for DUI after driving her vehicle and parking it illegally.
- On 3/18/2005 at about 22:30, a twenty-five year old Moscow man was arrested for DUI. The man had called the Moscow Police Department after wrecking his vehicle at the intersection of Palouse River Drive and Lenville Road (no one was injured in the collision). The man had called MPD and had told authorities he'd wrecked the car and that he had been drinking prior to having done so. LCSO responded to the crash and DUI.
- On 3/19/2005 at about 02:00, a Moscow man was arrested for both DUI and DWP after a traffic stop at the intersection of 4th and Washington Street in Moscow. The man had been driving erratically.



Safety Tip:

and walking on our many county roads. Remember to walk against traffic if you are walking on a shoulder of any road; that way both you and on-coming traffic can spot each other before it is too late.

Be a Good Witness:

Do you suspect drug or other illegal activity in your neighborhood? The best way you can be a hero is to be a good witness. Take notes about suspicious activity that include dates, times, and vivid descriptions about what you observe. If you see a suspicious vehicle, try to identify it by make, model, color, and by its license plate number and state. If you see a suspicious person, identify him or her by height, weight, age, hair color, and any distinguishing characteristics like scars, marks, tattoos, piercings, and clothing. Stay a safe distance away while you gather this information. You cannot provide information to us if something bad happens to you. Be safe.
