### Alternatives to Violence Domestic Violence Definition

Domestic Violence is a pattern of behavior used to establish power and control over another person through fear and intimidation. Acts of domestic violence fall into one or more categories, including physical battering, sexual abuse, and emotional/psychological abuse. Children, regardless of whether they have experienced abuse directly, are affected by violence and abuse in the home. Children who witness abuse often display the same emotional responses as children who have been physically and emotionally abused.

### Safety Tip: Gangs



We don't usually think of this area as being particularly “gang ridden,” but gangs are starting to show increasing presence throughout the State of Idaho. Our best tool in stopping our children from joining street gangs is our attention and love. If you start to see changes in your child, communicate with him/her. While we used to think of clothing and music preferences as possible indicators of gang activity, these are no longer integral to gang life. Talk with your children, know who their friends are, meet their friends and their friends' parents. Attend activities with your kids, chaperone events, and watch how the kids interact. Be wary of secrecy and non-communicative responses. You aren't being invasive; you are being a parent.
