- On 05/23/2005, at 00:22, a woman called the Latah County Sheriff's Office because an intoxicated man had entered her home and refused to leave. The reporting party was not familiar with the man, a 35 year old Moscow man who was subsequently arrested for unlawful entry.

Off to the right you can see the chart that shows the different calls we responded to in the past week. Ever wonder about the nature of the "All other responses" category? The Sheriff's Office also receives calls ranging from abandoned vehicles (four in this week) to welfare checks (eleven this week). We do out on alarm calls, civil standby events, suspicious circumstances calls, medical calls, noise complaints, and death investigations.
