




## Scope of North Idaho Adjudication

### Water rights administration

- For IDWR to be able to administer a water right:
  - A water district is created.
    - Idaho Code § 42-604 directs IDWR to divide the state into water districts.
  - The water right must be decreed or based upon license or permit.
    - IDWR cannot administer constitutional rights (aka beneficial use rights).


## 2008 Idaho Legislature

- Change in scope of the adjudication.
  - ➤ Petition must include a request for the deferral of domestic and stockwater rights as defined by Idaho Code § 42-1401A (4) and (11).
  - ➤ Petition must request that a commencement order be issued only if the court determines it is possible to defer the domestic and stockwater rights within the terms of the McCarran amendment.

## Petition to Commence Coeur d'Alene River Basin Adjudication

- Draft petition complete.
  - Describes boundary for the adjudication.
  - ➤ Requests that court defer small domestic and stockwater claims consistent with Idaho Code 42-1406b.
- State welcomes comments from United States and Tribes on draft petition.
- State wants to work with United States and Tribes to try to have petition filed no later than June 16, 2008.

# Boundary for Coeur d'Alene River Basin Adjudication



## Spokane River Basin / Pend Oreille River Basin Divide

- Boundaries based upon geographical divide of surface water.
- Surface water from Lake Pend Oreille flows north then west into Pend Oreille River Basin.

## Spokane River Basin / Pend Oreille River Basin Divide

- USGS reports suggest that some water from Lake Pend Oreille seeps into Spokane River Basin.
- Amount is "very uncertain."
- Best estimate is 36,000 AFA (based on mass balance modeling).
- Compare to the 4,475,000 AFA of water that leaves Spokane River basin (0.8%).
- Compare also to the 17,633,000 AFA of water that leaves the Pend Oreille River basin (0.2%).
- Given the geographical divide, logical to divide the adjudication here.

# Stipulation Regarding Small Domestic and Stockwater Rights

## Stipulation

- How does this stipulation compare with the SRBA Stipulation?
  - Almost identical to the SRBA stipulation.
  - Changed name of adjudication and updated citations.

## What does the stipulation do?

 Stipulation provides that a claim to a water right in the adjudication may, but is not required, to be filed for small domestic and stockwater rights at this time.

## What types of water rights are deferrable?

 Only small domestic and stockwater rights as defined by Idaho Code § 42-1401A (4) and (11) are deferrable.

## Small Domestic Water Rights

Domestic use includes the use of water for homes, organization camps, public campgrounds, livestock, and any other purpose in connection therewith, including the irrigation of up to ½ acres of land, if the total use is not in excess of 13,000 gallons per day.

 Other uses that do not meet the definition of domestic uses above are limited to a diversion rate of .04 cfs and a diversion volume of 2,500 gallons per day.

### Stockwater uses:

• The use of water solely for livestock where the total diversion is not in excess of 13,000 gallons per day.

## Key Points of the Stipulation:

- Deferred water right holders are joined to the adjudication. They are bound by terms and decisions of the adjudication.
- Only those domestic and stock water rights that qualify as domestic and stock water uses under Idaho Code § 42-1401A (4) and (11) would be deferrable. No other water uses can be deferred.

## Key Points of the Stipulation:

 The stipulation sets out the specific process should the need to adjudicate a deferred right arise in the future.

## Benefit to having water right adjudicated

- IDWR can only administer decreed and licensed/permitted water rights.
  - ► Idaho Code, Section 42-607
- An unadjudicated beneficial use water right goes to the bottom of the priority list.
  - ► Nettleton v. Higginson, 98 Idaho 87 (1977).

## Bottom line for deferred water rights

 Water users who want their deferred water rights administered will need to have their water right adjudicated first.


## IDWR will be encouraging claims

#### > IDWR will explain:

- If someone wants their deferred right administered or delivered in the future, they must get their water right decreed.
- Only costs \$25 now. Cost to get a water right adjudicated later will likely be much more expensive.
- If someone wants to change an element of a deferred water right through an administrative proceeding, they will first be required to have the water right decreed.

## Why defer small domestic and stockwater rights?

- Consistent with the Snake River Basin Adjudication.
- Practical way to deal with small water rights that have very little impact on water system.
- By deferring the small domestic and stockwater rights, we save time and resources.
- Should the need arise for administration of a deferred water right, a path exists to adjudicate the right. Thus, we expend resources on the de minimis rights only when necessary.

  - > 4,475,000 AFA
- USGS estimated groundwater pumpage from domestic supply wells from entire Rathdrum Prairie Aquifer (Idaho and Washington).
  - >20,270 AFA
  - **>.4%**
