

30 • 30 • 30 RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The 30 • 30 • 30 is a month long art event. Each selected participant will create 30 original works of art in a 30 day time frame and sell their works for \$30 each in a one day art sale. The challenge of completing 30 works of art in 30 days helps motivate the participants to explore and exhibit new ideas in a short period of time.

30 • 30 • 30 Fees and Information:

A \$30 entry fee will be charged per selected participant.

All artists 18 years and older may apply to the Jury, however, only 30 artists will be selected from the Jury to participate in the 30 • 30 • 30 art event. All selected artists may work in 2D – painting, fiber art, photography, drawing, encaustic, mixed media, printmaking, etc. The selected participants will be provided with 30 (thirty) - 6”x6” canvas board panels stamped especially for the 30 • 30 • 30.

Selected participants are responsible for picking up their 30 (thirty) canvas boards on October 20, 2014 at Moscow City Hall (206 East Third Street) First Floor from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. *No extensions will be offered.* Participants may make arrangements, *in advance*, to have someone else pick up their canvas boards for them.

Selected participants are responsible for dropping off their completed thirty (30) canvas boards at the end of the 30 • 30 • 30 on November 19, 2014 at Moscow City Hall (206 East Third Street) First Floor from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. All work must be original and created during the 30 • 30 • 30 event by the solo artist. *No extensions will be offered.* Participants may make arrangements, *in advance*, to have someone else drop off their completed boards for them.

30 • 30 • 30 Selected Participant Important Dates:

October 20, 2014 (Monday) 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. – Moscow City Hall

- Participants are required to pick up their event package; including thirty (30) canvas boards, the event rules, general guidelines, and more
- No extensions will be offered. Participants may make arrangements in advance to have someone else pick up their event package for them.

October 20, 2014 (Monday) through **November 19, 2014** (Wednesday)

- Participants have 30 days to create 30 works of art.

November 19, 2014 (Wednesday) 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. – Moscow City Hall

- Participants are required to drop off their completed thirty (30) canvas boards.
- *No extensions will be offered.* Participants may make arrangements in advance to have someone drop off their completed boards for them.

Art Exhibition and Sale:

The 30 • 30 • 30 art exhibition will be at the Third Street Gallery in Moscow. A Sneak Peek exhibit will be held on December 4, 2014 (12:00 to 5:00 p.m.) and December 5, 2014 (8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.). The Sneak Peek is free and open to the general public. *No works will be for sale during the Sneak Peek.* Participants are encouraged to bring any collectors, friends, or family members to the Sneak Peek. The One Day Sale is December 5, 2014 from 4:05 – 7:00 p.m., free and open to the general public. The Third Street Gallery is located on the second and third floors of Moscow's beautifully renovated and historic City Hall at 206 East Third Street.

All 30 • 30 • 30 artworks will be offered for sale in the Third Street Gallery on December 5, 2014 from 4:05 – 7:00 p.m. Each work will be offered for sale at \$30.

On December 5, 2014 during the One Day Sale, anyone interested in purchasing a piece will remove it from the gallery wall/display and proceed to the sales table to pay for their purchase(s). All sales will be made either by cash, check, or credit card the night of the Art Exhibition and Sale on December 5, 2014 between 4:05 – 7:00 p.m.

SALES:

The City of Moscow will collect a commission of twenty percent (20%) and six percent (6%) sales tax of all art sales during the 30 • 30 • 30 Art Exhibition.

Check Out and Pick Up of Unsold Works:

PLEASE NOTE: Pick up unsold work and check out: 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. December 9, 2014. Works left after December 9, 2014 will have a \$10 storage and handling fee assessed for each week until the works are picked up (unless special arrangements are made in advance). Artwork left after January 26, 2015 will become the property of the City of Moscow.

Notes:

The Moscow Arts Commission reserves the right to determine the suitability of artwork shown in the 30 • 30 • 30 exhibit.

Finished artwork will only be accepted on the November 19, 2014 deliver date from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. *No extensions will be offered.*

All work must be original and created during the 30 • 30 • 30 art event by the solo artist. All work must be created or mounted on the 6"x6" canvas boards provided. If a participant needs a replacement canvas board they may purchase one at their own cost. The replacement board must be a blank 6"x6" canvas panel(s) and it must be similar to the 6"x6" canvas panels provided for the event. All replacement canvas panels must be stamped for the event by the Arts Department at Moscow City Hall (206 East Third Street) First Floor. To be eligible for a 30 • 30 • 30 stamp the replacement canvas panel must be blank and unused.

Artists whose medium is not best suited for a canvas board may create their work(s) on alternate material and adhere the finished work to the canvas board provided. Please ensure that all works submitted in this format are in good condition and will withstand the ordinary strains of packing, transportation, and exhibition. Work may have a relief of 2-inches. *Please note that no work may extend beyond the edges of the 6"x6" canvas board.*

Artists are encouraged to sign the front of each work. Artists may include basic contact information on the back of each work.

Participants are to label the back of all finished artwork with their name, the title of the work, the medium the work is done in, and the direction each work should be hung in (on the back of each work, draw an arrow pointing in the direction of the top of the artwork). Please use the labels provided on the back of the canvas boards. No wet artwork will be accepted.

The canvas boards cannot be mounted together or attached to another board.

In order to participate in this event, each artist shall sign a Third Street Gallery Exhibit Agreement. All art works will be submitted, handled, and exhibited at the full liability of the artist.

Artists shall release the City of Moscow to use photographs and/or video of them and their exhibited art works, for future publicity and promotional purposes without copyright, use fees, or charges.
