Applications are due by 5:00 p.m. the Wednesday prior to the Jury date.

The jurists will screen and jury all new potential walk-on craft and/or food vendors for the 2015 Moscow Farmers Market. Space is limited; get your application in today! Participants will be provided a 3' x 3' table space to showcase their crafts and/or edible foods they would like to sell at the Moscow Farmers Market. **Photos of craft and/or food items will not be accepted.** If a participant is unable to physically attend the jury, a friend or family member may set-up their space for them.

Procedure for All Participants:

Fill out and turn in a Jury application by 5:00 p.m. the *Wednesday* prior to the Jury date. The day of the Jury, check-in and set-up your space at Moscow City Hall between 11:00 – 11:45 a.m. At 11:45 a.m. you will be required to leave the building so the Jury may begin. You may return at 2:00 p.m. to pick-up your items. Please have your space cleared by 2:30 p.m.

Craft Participants:

All craft participants must provide:

- Samples of all crafts to be juried.
- A 3x5 card for each item that includes: information on where the supplies came from, how and where the item was produced, and how much the item will be sold for.
- A 3x5 card listing the City and State you live in.
- An 8x10 photo showing how the booth would look at the Moscow Farmers Market.

Food Participants:

Food participants must provide:

- A copy of a food risk assessment form. Contact Nancy Becker at the North Central Health District to obtain a copy of this form. (208) 882-7506.
- Edible samples of all foods to be juried. For food mixes, prepare and serve the mix according to
 the directions given. Include examples of the packaging these foods will be sold in. All food
 packaging must be labeled with the participants name; address; ingredients listed in order of
 volume (most to least); and potential allergenic ingredients. The participant's phone number on
 the label is recommended but not required.
- A 3x5 card for each food that includes information on where each ingredient came from, how and where the food was produced, and how much the item will be sold for.
- A 3x5 card listing the City and State you live in.
- An 8x10 photo showing how the booth would look at the Moscow Farmers Market.

The jurying will be based on:

Local * Original * Homegrown * Quality of Materials and craftsmanship * Origin of products used (No commercial items, commercial kits, imported items, franchises, or second hand items are allowed)
