

**THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

**ORDER ENDING PUBLIC ACCESS RESTRICTIONS TO
LATAH COUNTY FACILITIES**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Latah County has authority pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 31-807 and 31-2009 to control the property of Latah County; and

WHEREAS, the health and safety of all Latah County residents, patrons and employees is the greatest priority of the Board of Latah County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, by Order on March 18, 2020 and March 19, 2020 the Board of County Commissioners authorized and directed its Chair to issue an Order and Supplemental Order Restricting Public Access to Latah County Facilities with such administrative conditions and provisions as may be appropriate; and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2021, Governor Brad Little moved Idaho to Stage 4 of the Idaho Rebounds Plan and updated the “Stay Healthy Guidelines”; and

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention updated its Covid-19 recommendations on May 16, 2021 to state that fully vaccinated people can resume activities they did prior to the pandemic without wearing a mask or physical distancing; and


WHEREAS, the Public Health-Idaho North Central District has indicated that cases of COVID-19 in the area have been declining.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The March 18, 2020 and March 19, 2020 Order and Supplemental Order Restricting Public Access to Latah County Facilities are **HEREBY TERMINATED**. All Latah County facilities, including the Latah County Courthouse, Latah County Annex, McConnell Mansion, Latah County Fairgrounds and the office of the Latah County Historical Society will return to pre-COVID accessibility on May 20, 2021.
2. It is recommended that any member of the public who is not fully vaccinated against COVID continue to wear a face covering and maintain six foot physical distancing when visiting Latah County facilities.
3. Restrictions and limitations on access to Court facilities shall continue to be determined by order of the Idaho Supreme Court.
4. Individual County offices and departments may adopt reasonable policies regarding access and conduct of persons on their premises in consultation with the Latah County Board of County Commissioners and/or Office of the Prosecuting Attorney.

This Order shall be effective as of **8 a.m. on Thursday, May 20, 2021** and shall remain in full force and effect until otherwise modified by the Board of County Commissioners.
