1 Dalynne Singleton has qualified and is being appointed as Resident Agent since Petitioner
2 resides in Kansas.

3 NOTICES. No advance notice of the hearing on this petition for appointment or for
4 non-intervention powers was required because the Will designates the Petitioner as the
5 personal representative, Petitioner is the surviving spouse of decedent, more than forty (40)
6 days has passed since Decedent's death and no special notice has been requested.

8 PETITIONERS' NON-INTERVENTION POWERS. The offered Will is established
9 as Decedent's Will and admitted to probate. The Petitioner is designated in said Will as the
10 Personal Representative which Will directs that Petitioner shall be granted non-intervention
