Petitioner, SHEILA LEE MCDONALD, by and through counsel undersigned, declares under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington that the following is true and correct to the best of his/her knowledge:

- 1. <u>JURISDICTION</u>. DONNA M NEWTON, (hereinafter "Decedent") died Testate on February 27, 2022, and was a resident of King County, leaving property and claims in the State of Washington subject to probate. The undersigned Petitioner is one of two adult children of Decedent. A copy of the Death Certificate is attached.
- 2. <u>WILL</u>. Decedent died leaving a Will dated September 29, 2018, which will be filed in these proceedings. The Sworn Statement /Declarations of Attesting Witnesses in support of the Will are filed herewith pursuant to RCW 11.20.020 and RCW 11.12.160. Subscribing Witnesses are Esperanza Barboa and Jennifer Yokoyama.

- 3. <u>PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE.</u> The Petitioner is the daughter of the Decedent. Petitioner is a resident of the State of Washington, County of Snohomish, and is willing and legally qualified to act as the personal representative. In the Last Will and Testament, Decedent named her daughter, SHEILA LEE MCDONALD, to act as personal representative, to serve without Bond and with Nonintervention Powers. Petitioner is not a creditor of the estate.
- 4. <u>BOND/NONINTERVENTION POWERS</u>. Petitioner requests that the Court waive bond in this estate and that she be given authority to act without court intervention, pursuant to the Will of Decedent.

- 6. <u>NOTICE</u>. Petitioner is the daughter of Decedent and named as Personal Representative in Decedent's Will. No advance notice of the hearing on this petition for appointment or for non-intervention powers is required and no special notice has been requested. See RCW 11.20.020 & 11.68.011.
- 7. <u>GUARDIAN/ACCOUNT FOR MINOR GRANDCHILD</u>. The minor granddaughter of Decedent, Nyah Bradley, is 17 years old and her legal guardian is her father, Thomas L. Bradley. Nyah resides with her father. Nyah's mother is deceased. The court is requested to appoint as probate legal guardian of Nyah Bradley, her father Thomas L. Bradley. Nyah will obtain the age of 21 in October, 2025. An account will be set up for the minor granddaughter and will be blocked until the age of 21 pursuant to the Will. It is requested that the funds be available to Nyah upon her 21st birthday and she be able to withdraw those funds without further order from the Court. A receipt for the blocked account will be filed with this Court.
- 8. <u>ESTATE SOLVENCY</u>. The value of Decedent's assets at death exceeded the value of her liabilities by at least \$50,000, so Decedent died solvent. The major asset of the estate is bank account and cash valued in excess of \$75,000. Furthermore, the value of all expenses of the estate, including taxes and fees and costs of administration, should not exceed \$5,000.00 so Decedent's estate is now and should remain solvent.

- REQUEST TO COURT: Petitioner requests that the court determine and 9. order that:
 - 1. The Testate estate be opened;
 - Establish and admit to probate Decedent's Last Will and Testament 2. filed herein as the true Last Will and Testament of DONNA M NEWTON;
 - Confirm SHEILA LEE MCDONALD as Personal Representative, 3. to serve without bond, and without court intervention;
 - Issue Letters Testamentary to SHEILA LEE MCDONALD upon 4. the filing of an Oath; and
 - Declare this estate to be solvent. 5.
 - Thomas L. Bradley to be appointed as the probate legal guardian of 6. Nyah Bradley and upon receipt of the distribution from the Estate, to be authorized to set up a blocked account for Nyah Bradley which pursuant to the Will, the account will be blocked until Nyah reaches the age of 21. For Nyah Bradley to be able to withdraw the funds upon her 21st birthday without further order of the court.
