- 1. **Decedents. EDWARD RODNEY NEWMAN** and **LOIS EULA NEWMAN**, husband and wife, (the decedents) were both residents of Sequim, Clallam County, Washington. Edward Rodney Newman ("Edward") died on May 8, 2015. Lois Eula Newman ("Lois") died on March 28, 2022. They owned property in Sequim, Clallam County, Washington which is subject to probate.
- 2. **Will**. There was no Will found for decedent Edward. Decedent Lois left a document purporting to be her Last Will and Testament ("Lois' Will") which was executed on June 10, 2015, in the presence of competent witnesses. Lois was legally competent to execute her Will. Lois' Will nominated and appointed her daughter, Kathy Danley to act as Personal Representative without bond. - 5. **Solvency of estate**. The decedents' estate is solvent, taking into account probate and non-probate assets. Petitioner represents that decedents' estate consists of real property and other assets, all of which assets are believed to exceed \$100,000.00 in value. The known debts of the decedents are believed to be less than \$50,000.
- 6. **Nonintervention powers**. Administration and settlement of the decedents' Will and estate with nonintervention powers would be in the best interest of the decedent's beneficiaries and creditors.
- 7. **Administration as Single Estate**. Petitioner requests authority to administer both estates as a single probate action in the interest of efficiency and cost-effectiveness, and in view of the presumption that the assets of both estates are community property.
- 8. **Notice of hearing on petition**. Advance notice of the hearing on this petition is not required based upon Petitioner being named as Personal Representative in the decedents' Wills. RCW 11.68.041(1).

WHEREFORE, petitioner prays for an order of this Court as follows:

1. That decedents' Will be established as the Last Will and Testament of decedent and admitted to probate;

- 2. That Petitioner be appointed as Personal Representative of the decedents' joint estates, to act without bond;
- 3. That Petitioner be granted nonintervention powers entitling Petitioner to administer and close the decedents' joint estates without further Court intervention or supervision;
- 4. For such other and further relief as the court may deem just and equitable.
