QUIT-CLAIM DEED

One hundred DOLLAR Lawful money of the United States of America to the said hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said parties of the second part, and to their executors, heirs and assigns, the following described tracts of land situate lying and being in the County of King, State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Lot Four (4) and the south half quarter of the south half quarter (9.8 x 9.8) of Section Seven (7), and Lots one (1) and Two (2) Section eighteen (18) all in Township Twenty three (23) North of Range Five (5) East containing One Hundred & eighth & one half (108 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) acres more or less.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.

To Have and to Hold, all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the said parties of the second part, and to their executors, heirs and assigns forever


