WHEREFORE, the Petitioner asks that the Court enter an Order as follows:

- 1. That the Personal Representative above-named has exercised reasonable diligence in the conduct of a review and inquiry for the purpose of determining reasonably ascertainable creditors of the Decedent.
- 2. That the review included correspondence (including correspondence received after the date of death) and financial records (including checkbooks, bank statements, income tax returns, etc.) in the possession of the Personal Representative or reasonably available to her, as well as inquiry of the Decedent's heirs, devisees, and legatees regarding potential claimants.
 - 3. That creditors not ascertained to date are not reasonably ascertainable.
- 4. That all creditors who have not filed their claims against the above estate prior to the expiration of the limitation period established pursuant to RCW 11.40.051 are now barred by said statute from further pursuing claims against the above Estate.
